Laurel Caverns in the southwestern Laurel Highlands is Pennsylvania's first underground state park!

The largest and deepest cave in the Commonwealth, visitors can find over four miles of cave passages beneath a 435-acre geological park. A comfortable 52 degrees year-round, the cave provides critical winter habitat for endangered bat species.
